It is my opinion the lettering on the interior of the cotton belt reads: From left to right:

"Rebel Belt B."

It appears as though there may be additional initials after the "B" but they are too faded to read. The lettering appears to be written with iron gall ink and has degraded as is typical with the wear and age of the belt. The ink has faded with exposure to light, but has also bled and faded from being exposed to moisture. Under ultraviolet fluorescence, the remaining iron in the ink is visible.






